# RULES GOVERNING THE CEDAR VALLEY MIXED CITY TOURNAMENT

Must be a member of the Greater Cedar Valley Bowling Association or Cedar Falls Bowling Association and meet the average requirements.

1. ENTRY FEES - \$10.00 per bowler each event. All events \$1.00 per bowler.
2. PRIZES - At least ONE in FOUR ENTRIES for team and doubles and ONE in TEN for all events.
3. HANDICAP - 100% of 220.
4. AVERAGE - 1) Bowler's highest USBC league average of 21 games or more in the Greater Cedar Valley or Cedar Falls Association in the 08-09 season will be used, 2) Previous summer average of 21 games or more, 3) NEW BOWLERS - if bowler did not bowl in the 08-09 season and does not have a summer average, the bowler will use the highest USBC league average of the current season of 21 games or more as of tournament participation. If a bowler does not have 21 games then assigned averages will be 170 for women and 200 for men. If at the time of bowling an entrant has a current average for 21 or more games that is 15 pins or more higher than the prior season's average, the current average must be used. Failure to use the proper average or make a correction prior to completion of the first game of a series shall disqualify the score if the submitted average is lower than the actual average. Prize Winnings will be based on the submitted average if it is higher. Rule 319d,e waived.
5. TEAM LINEUP - Any combination of four men and women, but must have at least one male or female on each team.  
DOUBLES - Mixed doubles only.
6. BOWLING MORE THAN ONCE - May bowl team more than once, but must change at least 2 bowlers on the team. May bowl Mixed Doubles more than once, but with a different partner.
7. ALL EVENTS - The FIRST Team score and the FIRST Doubles score rolled will be used for the six game All Events score.
8. No line-up changes other than substitutions after the close of entries.
9. Any bowler or team arriving after the game has started is allowed to bowl, and the score(s) count beginning in the frame then being bowled. NO SCORE WILL BE GIVEN FOR FRAMES MISSED.
10. Each event shall be rolled on one pair of lanes.
11. In the case of a tie for first place in any event, co-champions will be declared. Prize money for the appropriate number of places will be divided equally.
12. No pacers will be allowed.
13. Full remittance must accompany Entry Blank. Entries will be scheduled as received. NO EXCEPTIONS.
14. A protest regarding eligibility or playing rules must be confirmed in writing and filed with tournament management, the local association or to USBC prior to the payment of tournament prizes. The time limit for correcting errors in scoring will be 24 hours.

15. The decision of the association board shall be final unless an appeal is made in accordance with Rule 329.
