RULES

- All bowlers must check in 1/2 hour before scheduled time to bowl. Please bring your membership card.
- Bowlers will use the average posted January 1.
- Medals will be awarded to the first three places in all of the events.
- Ribbons will be awarded for 4th and 5th places and participation ribbons for all others.
- If you need to bowl at times not listed please contact the tournament manager, Loretta Wander, 277-6745, to see if lanes are available.
- NO REFUNDS AFTER CLOSING DATE.
- Once bowling has begun, be prepared to bowl when it is your turn. 0 score is recorded for frames missed.
- Dress Code Rule - **Please wear your bowling jersey**. Jeans may be worn as long as they are worn appropriately, have no holes or are frayed. No hats are to be worn. Plain tee shirts or collared shirts with no objectionable sayings or graphics.
- Cell phones, ipods and all electronic devices must be turned off during competition.
