Open to All Greater Cedar Valley Youth

DATES: January 21 and 22, 2012

CENTER: Cadillac Lanes

ENTRIES: Open: December 1 Close: January 10

Competition in Bantam (11 & Under - total of ages 45 or less), Junior (12 - 14 - total of ages 46 to 59) and Senior (15 & Over - total of ages 60 and over) divisions in each event. Ages will be averaged to determine division.

LATE ENTRIES will be accepted at discretion of the tournament manager.

EVENTS: Team - 4 Bowlers per team - Boys, Girls or Mixed

Doubles - 2 Bowlers per entry - Boys, Girls or Mixed

Singles - 1 Bowler per entry

All Events - Both Handicap and Scratch Divisions

HDCP: 100% of the difference between the bowlers average and 210.

FEES: \$9.00 per event per bowler (\$27 total for all three events) - Three games are bowled in each event.

There is No Entry Fee for All Events

RULES

1. All entrants may register ONCE in each event, but may also bowl as a substitute in an emergency. First score bowled will count for All Events.
2. All regular teams are encouraged to bowl together. All substitutes must be approved by the league coach and tournament manager.
3. All bowlers should check in 1/2 hour before scheduled time to bowl. Late bowlers will receive 0 pin fall for frames missed.
4. Bowlers will use the average posted January 1 in a regular league. Traveling league average is excluded unless that is the only league where there is an established average. Bowlers with fewer than 12 games at the time entries close will use yearbook average. If none, the following averages will be used: 11 & Under assigned 120, 12-14 assigned 150 and 15 & Over assigned 180.
5. Team and Double Divisions will be determined by the average of the ages. No change in division after bowling begins each shift. A bowler must bowl both doubles and singles. You must bowl all three (3) events to qualify for All Events. Make sure AGE AS Of AUGUST 1 is used.
6. Absentee scores may be used in an emergency. (Average minus 10 pins + handicap)
7. No use of tobacco or alcohol by Youth Bowling participants OR ADULTS during the tournament.
8. Medals will be awarded to first three places in each Age Division for each event, including All Events. Medals will be awarded for the individual High Handicap series in each age division for both boys and girls.
9. Ribbons will be awarded to 4th and 5th places in all divisions, and participation ribbons for everyone in 11 and under.
10. If you need to bowl at times not listed (such as all on one day) please contact the tournament manager, Loretta Wander, 277-6745, to see if lanes are available to accommodate your request.
11. NO REFUNDS AFTER CLOSING DATE.
12. Once bowling has begun, be prepared to bowl when it is your turn. 0 score is recorded for frames missed.
13. Dress Code Rule - **Please wear your bowling jersey**. Jeans may be worn as long as they are worn appropriately, have no holes or are frayed. No hats are to be worn. Plain T-shirts or collared shirts with no objectionable sayings or graphics.
14. Cell phones, iPods and all electronic devices must be turned off during competition.

If you need bowlers to bowl with you for Doubles or to make up a team - ask your coach to help you.**
