



## NOMINATION FORM FOR GREATER CEDAR VALLEY USBC HALL OF FAME

The Greater Cedar Valley Hall of Fame was created to perpetuate the names of those who have displayed outstanding ability in the game of bowling or who have contributed through meritorious service to the welfare and progress of bowling.

On the following pages you will find the requirements to nominate a bowler for the Greater Cedar Valley Bowling Hall of Fame. Anyone can nominate a bowler. Once nominated, all eligible application will be reviewed by the Hall of Fame Committee. Please note, the Hall of Fame Committee does not research additional information about a nominee, all information must be provided within the nomination and supporting write-up.

If a nominee is not selected the first year, his/her nomination will be carried over for two additional years. After three years, if they are not selected, the candidate's name will be removed from the nomination list and will need to be resubmitted for future consideration.

### **Nomination Categories:**

An individual may be nominated for the Greater Cedar Valley in one or both of the following categories:

**Skill** – this candidate should have outstanding achievements in leagues, City Tournaments, Iowa State Tournaments, Women's National Championship, Open National Championship, or other Tournaments.

**Meritorious Service** – this candidate should have made outstanding contributions to the good and welfare of the game through administrative or organizational work, or in any other manner deemed meritorious.

### **Eligibility:**

An individual becomes eligible to be nominated for the Greater Cedar Valley Bowling Association Hall of Fame when a combination of their age (as of February 15 of the current year) and the number of years bowled in the Greater Cedar Valley Bowling Association (excluding junior leagues) totals 60 or more. Posthumous is exempt from this requirement.

### **Nomination Requirements:**

To nominate an individual for the Greater Cedar Hall of Fame the following will need to be completed:

- Cover Page – use the attached form.
- Outline of Accomplishments – use the attached form.
- Supporting Write-Up – each nomination should also include a written component, expanding on the information from the outline of accomplishments. This written component should tell the story of the nominee and should communicate with the Hall of Fame Committee information on the achievements and/or contributions the nominee has made to bowling.
