Open to All Youth bowling in Greater Cedar Valley certified USBC Youth Leagues.

DATES: February 7 & 8

CENTER: Cadillac XBC

ENTRIES: Open now, Close January 26

Team Divisions: U12, U16, U18 (based on age of the oldest bowler)

Doubles event: U12, U16, U18 (based on age of the oldest bowler)

LATE ENTRIES: accepted at discretion of the tournament manager.

EVENTS: Team - 4 bowlers - Boys, Girls, or Mixed. (\$10 per bowler/\$40 per team)

Doubles - 2 Bowlers - Boys, Girls, or Mixed (\$10 per bowler/\$20 per set)

Singles - Boys, Girls. (\$10 per bowler)

Optional All Events - Boys, Girls. (\$1 per bowler)

Optional Scratch Singles and All Events - Boys, Girls, no age requirement. (\$5 per bowler)

HDCP: 100% of the difference between the bowlers average and 210.

FEES: \$10 per event per bowler, 3 event total per person \$30, with optional All Events \$31, with optional Scratch Sgls and AE \$36.

RULES

1. **TEAM:** Multiple participation allowed in the team event only. At least two members of the lineup must be different on each entry.
DOUBLES/SINGLES: A bowler must enter both Doubles and Singles. Doubles will be bowled first.
All EVENTS: First score bowled in an event will count for All Events.
SCRATCH SINGLES AND ALL EVENTS: Must be entered in All Events and Singles. Boys, Girls, no age requirement.
A bowler may also bowl as a substitute in an emergency, but the first score bowled will count for All Events.
2. Team and Double Divisions will be determined by the age of the oldest bowler. No change in division after bowling begins each shift. AGE AS OF AUGUST 1 will be used.
3. All bowlers must check in 1/2 hour before scheduled time to bowl. Late bowlers will receive 0 pinfall for frames missed.
4. Bowlers will use the GCV USBC certified average posted January 26 in a regular league. Bowlers with fewer than 12 games at the time entries close will use the previous season yearbook average. If none, the following averages will be used: U12 assigned 110, U16 assigned 150 and U18 assigned 180.
5. Medals will be awarded ONE in THREE entries, up to three places in each Division for each event, including Scratch Singles and All Events. Medals will be awarded for the individual High Handicap series in the team event in each age division for both boys and girls.
6. NO REFUNDS AFTER CLOSING DATE.
7. Once bowling has begun, be prepared to bowl when it is your turn. 0 score is recorded for frames missed.
8. Dress Code Rule - Please wear your bowling jersey or an appropriate shirt with no objectionable sayings or graphics. Jeans may be worn as long as they are worn appropriately. No hats are to be worn unless for medical reason. Swearing, inappropriate gestures and abusing equipment will not be tolerated.
9. Cell phones, iPods and all electronic devices must be turned off during competition.
10. A substitute or absentee score (average minus 10 pins + handicap) may be used in an emergency.
11. No use of tobacco, alcohol or vaping by youth bowling participants OR ADULTS during the tournament.
12. Photo Release- Staff and volunteers often take photographs during events. The photos may be used in our website and social media accounts.

Please talk to your parents and your team members about bowling in this Tournament.
If you need bowler(s) to bowl with you for Doubles or to make up a team - ask your coach to help you.
